

MINUTES

LAFAYETTE COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD

REGULAR MEETING, FEBRUARY 15, 2022

The Lafayette County School Board convened in regular session, Tuesday, February 15, 2022 beginning at 6:00 p.m. Present were Mr. Robert Edwards, Superintendent of Schools; Mrs. Amanda Hickman, Chairperson; Mrs. Marion McCray, Vice-Chair; Mr. Jeff Walker, Member; Mr. Darren Driver, Member; Mr. Taylor McGrew, Member; and Mrs. Leenette McMillan-Fredriksson, School Board Attorney. Administrators present were Mrs. Alissa Hingson, Director of Teaching and Learning Services and Mr. Stephen Clark, LES Principal.

CALL TO ORDER

Mrs. Amanda Hickman called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Mr. Taylor McGrew gave the invocation and Superintendent Robert Edwards led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

4.02 SCHOOL BOARD RATIFIES 2021-2022 LEA/SRP AGREEMENT/COVID LEAVE MOU -

Following discussion, Mr. Taylor McGrew moved to approve the 2021-2022 LEA/SRP Agreement/COVID leave MOU. Mrs. Marion McCray seconded the motion. The vote for approval was unanimous.

4.03 SCHOOL BOARD APPROVES AUDIT REPORT – Report No. 2022-094, a Financial and Federal Single Audit of Lafayette County District School Board, for fiscal year ended June 30, 2021 was presented for the Board's approval. Mrs. Marion McCray moved to approve the audit report. Mr. Jeff Walker gave the second. Motion carried unanimously. (Audit Report on file at district office)

4.04 EMERGENCY TRANSPORTATION AGREEMENT WITH LAFAYETTE NURSING AND REHABILITATION CENTER APPROVED- Superintendent Edwards explained the agreement. After a brief discussion a motion was made by Mr. Jeff Walker and a second by Mrs. Marion McCray. Motion carried unanimously. (Agreement on file in district office)

4.05 PUBLIC HEARING- Mrs. Hickman called the public hearing on instructional materials to be used for the 2022-2023 school year as advertised to order at 6:30 p.m. With no citizen input the public hearing was concluded on a motion by Mr. Darren Driver and a second by Mrs. Marion McCray the vote was unanimous. With the public hearing business concluded the regular board meeting resumed.

4.06 SCHOOL BOARD APPROVES PARAPROFESSIONAL POSITION AT LES – Following discussion, the School Board unanimously approved on a motion by Mrs. Marion McCray and a second by Mr. Taylor McGrew a 10 month Paraprofessional position at Lafayette Elementary School for the 2021-2022 school year.

4.07 SCHOOL BOARD APPROVES SPEECH PATHOLOGY AGREEMENT ADDENDUM- On a motion by Mr. Taylor McGrew and a second by Mrs. Marion McCray the School Board unanimously approved the Speech Pathology Agreement Addendum.


6. CITIZEN INPUT
