Current COVID19 Procedures

Students can make an appointment with their doctor to be COVID19 tested. If students test with a home test, they must scan the QR code on the box to get a text and/or email test result to bring to school for proof of testing. If they do not have a home test and are looking for a free test site, they can go to the drive through at CVS and/or Walgreens.

The quarantine period for positive COVID19 students is 5 days. Day 1 begins the day after symptoms started or if they tested positive and DO NOT have symptoms, Day 1 starts the day following positive test. You may return to school on Day 6.

If students test positive for COVID19, they may return to school when the following criteria have been met:

- The student receives a negative COVID19 test and is asymptomatic (no symptoms)
- Five days have passed since the onset of symptoms or positive test result, the student has had no fever for 24 hours and no medication was used to bring down the fever and the student's other symptoms have/are improving
- The student has written permission to return to school from a medical doctor

For students to have their absences excused they will need to provide ONE of the following:

- 1. Turn in a doctor's note with the dates for exclusion.
- 2. Turn in a printed copy of their test results from the home test (not a photo of the test kit results). Scan the QR code on the home test and follow the directions to get a copy of home test results.

<u>There is no close contact tracing</u>. If someone other than the student in the home has COVID, students need to attend school as long as they do not have symptoms. A student is only excused for COVID if they have a positive test, not because someone else in the home tested positive.
